RULES FOR COMPETITIONS (SOLO)

1. Rule 1 (Membership)

- 1.1 Each athlete in a WDSF Competition must be a member of, or formally affiliated with, a WDSF Member body representing a country.
- 1.2 All athletes in all WDSF Competitions must be identified by a WDSF ID Card/E-Card

2. Rule 2 (General)

- 2.1 Solo is a discipline in which the athlete competes alone, without a partner.
- 2.2 The athlete's performance shall contain all technical elements defined for Standard and/or Latin disciplines, with the exception of Hand Hold and Couple Position. The usage of arms and hands in Solo competition is without restriction.

3. Rule 3 (Discipline)

- 3.1 Solo Standard.
- 3.2 Solo Latin.
- 3.3 Solo 10 Dances.

4. Rule 4 (Dances by discipline)

- 4.1 In Solo Standard athletes compete in all 5 Standard dances: Waltz, Tango, Viennese Waltz, Slow Foxtrot and Quickstep.
- 4.2 Exception is the Juvenile I age category in which they compete in: Waltz, Tango, and Quickstep.
- 4.3 In Solo Latin athletes compete in all 5 Latin dances: Samba, Cha-Cha-Cha, Rumba, Paso Doble and Jive.

4.4 Exception is the Juvenile I age category in which they compete in: Samba, Cha-Cha-Cha and Jive.

WDSF will grant a series of WDSF Open Solo Competitions in Standard, Latin and 10 dance with points for the WDSF Solo World Ranking List for all age category according to the Rule E.2

All title events will be subject to the special decision of the WDSF Vice-President for Sports and WDSF Presidium.
